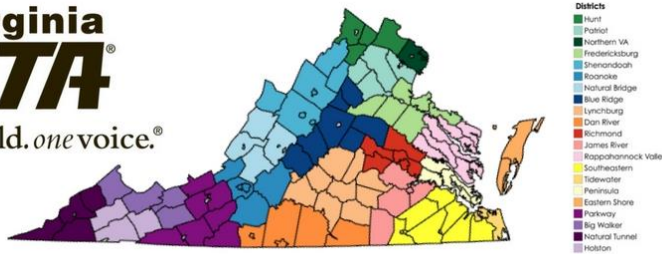

## The District Annual Calendar Includes:

- Fall Legislative Meeting – Discuss Proposed Legislative Program, advocacy priorities, potential Resolutions. May review district budgets with general membership.
- Student Recognition Event – Celebrate participants and winners of Student Programs. May be a stand-alone event or combined with another District meeting.
- Annual Meeting – Should be held in March or April before the Virginia PTA Spring Board meeting (typically held in May).
- Leadership Training for Local Leaders – May be combined with other District meetings.
